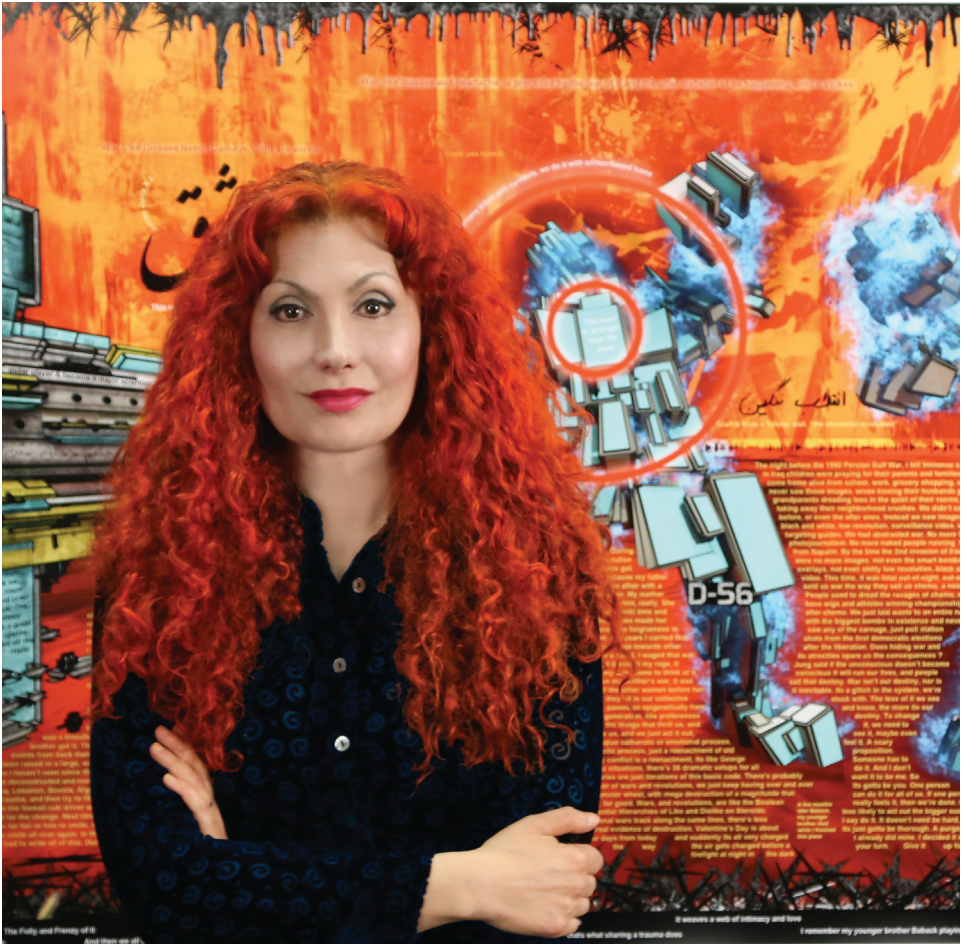

# ART STAR:

## MARJAN MOGHADDAM

**One of 3 artists featured in *Modern Utopias* as part of *Panorama: Image-Based Art in the 21st Century* on view at Main Line Art Center September 12 –November 4.**

Marjan Moghaddam is an award-winning New York City-based artist and animator working primarily with 3D computer graphics and digital media for print, video art, performance, and installation. Originally from Iran, Moghaddam immigrated to the US in 1979 after the Islamic revolution, and is a Full Professor of Computer Graphics and Animation at the Brooklyn campus of Long Island University.

Moghaddam's work has been exhibited extensively at various international galleries, museums and festivals, in addition to curated exhibits at the Armory Show in NYC and Art Basel Miami. She is a recipient of numerous grants for her innovative and cutting edge art, such as the Rockefeller Fund, NY Department of Cultural Affairs, Brooklyn Arts Council, and the Experimental Television Fund. Most recently, she was a winner in both print and animation categories of the Los Angeles New Media Festival and the Audience Best of Show Award at the Mobile and Humanity Art Show. Moghaddam's digital works can also be found in many private and institutional connections.

About her work, she simply states: "I aim to achieve the sublime in art with computer-based tools."
