Pastels

Bring to Class:

- Any brand of <u>Soft</u> pastels (at least 10 or as many as you want)
 - Beginners no need to buy an entire set of pastels, you can buy a small set or even a small amount of individual sticks. Instructor prefers the brand called Schminke, but students might hold off buying until first class.
- Pastel paper (any size, either white or neutral shade):
 - Instructor prefers the following brands of pastel paper: "Wallis" paper OR "Pastel Mat" paper. These papers can be purchased online through Dakota Art Supply website or the Dick Blick website (Blick also has a store in Philadelphia). These are teachers preferred papers, **BUT any pastel paper is** fine to bring.
- Other supplies:
 - A blending stump (also called tortillon)
 - o Old, used stiff bristle brush
