

Sketching at Chanticleer

With Carol Kardon

Students will explore the advantages of working with water-soluble graphite, doing small sketches. These sketches break down confusing landscape to simple, clearly defined forms and shapes. A demonstration and explanation of how to use the materials will begin the first day. Students will do several small sketches.

Paper

Any small sketch paper which is for water-based materials. Preferably a smooth surface rather than rough. Yuopo paper – only comes in pads, not sketch books, a small pad

Any water-soluble pencil – but here are some I have:

Derwent Graphitone 2B, 6B, 7B, 8B

Derwent Sketching Medium Wash 4B Dark Wash

Museum Aquarelle Caran d’Ache 3510.059 (Brown)

General’s Sketch and Wash #588

Faber Castell Graphite Aquarelle 8B

Small spray bottle for water

Small container for water

Small watercolor brush

Stool, hat with brim

Tissues or small rag
