

BERNICE PAUL

35+ Year Community Member... And Counting!

Bernice Paul is a 98-year-old painter based in Philadelphia. Originally from Moscow, Russia, Bernice immigrated to Philadelphia with her family through Ellis Island during the Depression when the Nazis were coming into power in Europe. Once settled in Philadelphia, Bernice studied art extensively at the Barnes Foundation, Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, Fleisher Art Memorial, and the Philadelphia College of Art...and of course, Main Line Art Center!

Bernice has been an important part of the Main Line Art Center community as a student and member for over 35 years. Currently a Professional Artist Member, Bernice most recently exhibited her work in our annual Members and Professional Artist Member exhibitions. She keeps coming back to the Art Center because of its "very good teachers, and being able to paint with other people who are interested in the same thing." For Bernice, her time here also means keeping up friendships with fellow painting students Louise Herring and Louise Clearfield, whom she has known since early days at Main Line Art Center, when workshops were still held in the attic!

Bernice's work has been exhibited extensively in the Greater Philadelphia area, including Fleisher Art Memorial, Philadelphia City Hall, Philadelphia Museum of Art, and Woodmere Art Museum, among others. Her vibrant artistic style has earned many awards, including recently at a juried exhibition of the Delaware County Art League, where her prize-winning still life was cited for its "exciting composition and the physicality and joy of the artist's brush strokes."
