## STUDENT SUPPLY LIST: Discovering Collage & Mixed Media '16

## BASIC Supplies BRING EVERY WEEK & First Class unless otherwise indicated. Teacher will email supplies needed before every class.

- Sharp Scissors
- 2-3-Assorted Inexpensive nylon brushes from art supply store –no hardware store brushes. <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> -3/4 " & 1"-2" wide flats. (Michael's or A.C. Moore is a good place to find)
- Ruler w/Metal edge
- Masonite or wood drawing board at least "16 "x 20" Approx. A MUST HAVE!
- Soft pencil #2b, 3B, etc
- Paper towel roll or paint rag
- 3-4 small plastic containers with lids. A MUST have!
- One large plastic water container.
- **Drafting** or low tack tape. (No masking or **colored** painter's tape)
- Small jar of acrylic matte medium 4-8 oz. (No MOD Podge!)
- Small jar of matte gel.
- Bristol board vellum pad at least **14"x 17**" 100 lb.
- Notebook
- A system for organizing, storing, and transporting your materials magazines, scrap papers, personal, and found items.
- 1 Colorful magazine

## PAPERS

- Decorative, Asian, and assorted papers you already may have.
- Found papers, envelopes postcard, tickets, greeting cards, laser copies of photos, etc.

## **OPTIONAL**

- Hair dryer
- 4-8 0z. semi-soft or soft gel medium
- Any coloring mediums you may already have such as watercolor pencils acrylic inks, oil pastels, gouache, etc. It is not necessary to buy any of these and teacher will let you know what to bring before each class.

Teacher will let you know what to bring to each class by email, so it's not necessary to bring all these materials to each class.
