# ART STAR

## BARRY SIMON

For over forty-five years, Barry Simon stuffed as much art into his free time as he could. During the day he worked as a Labor and Employment lawyer, but on Tuesday nights and Saturday mornings Barry took painting classes. Despite his love of art, he always put his career first and often spent years away from the canvas. When it came time to retire, Barry decided to turn in his license to practice law so he could put all of his focus on his passion—painting. For five years now, he's been coming to Main Line Art Center and recently began our **certificate program**.

Barry's goal for finishing his certification is to get his work into the Museum of Modern Art, or at least "get the paintings out of the basement and into public view." He's been successful so far, having shown in the galleries at Main Line Art Center and in group shows with the Delaware Valley Art League, even winning first place for one of them. Since coming to the Art Center, Barry has been grateful for the professional quality of his instructors who can give him feedback on his paintings and for the range in his fellow students who provide unique perspectives of his work. But, as it turns out, Barry has found more here than he expected. After registering for a class with Francine Shore, he says, "when I walked in, we discovered that we knew each other in junior high. I hadn't seen her since I was 15 years old! It was a fun reunion."

Main Line Art Center has been a great place for his family, as well. Barry and his wife often come to the exhibitions and events, and he loves buying Christmas presents for family and friends at the Art Center's Craft Sale. His youngest son has also taken classes over the years and volunteered as a Teaching Artist Assistant in Summer Art Camp. **Barry knows better than anyone that Main Line Art Center is "not just a place to take art classes. It's a great asset to the community where you can meet new people and catch up with old acquaintances."**
