Three Betsy Meyer Memorial Exhibition winners embed their work in the galleries this month. Paul Santoleri, a noted muralist and Artblog favorite, creates a room-spanning, baroque drawing installation that immerses you metaphorically in the life and death refugee crisis in the Mediterranean. Joanna Platt, a Tiger Strikes Asteroid member, uses networked light elements to create a statement on technology and community; and Kelley Donahue's patterned ceramics speak of the highly seductive process of drawing on 3D objects.
