# ART STAR:

LAVONNE MCCOMMONS



Facilitated by dedicated Main Line Art Center teaching artists and passionate volunteers, *Creating in Clay* at the Center for the Blind and Visually Impaired in Chester is one of our longest running Accessible Art Programs. Since the program launched over 50 years ago, countless artists have moved and inspired us with their stories and talents. Artists like Lavonne.

A self-proclaimed housewife with three grown children, Lavonne has been participating in *Creating in Clay* for about ten years. She was born sighted, but lost her vision to diabetes. Working with the clay is a special experience for Lavonne because she never wears gloves when sculpting. "Feeling the clay helps me to see," she says. This physical process evolved into something more when models were introduced into the program. Lavonne feels the model to see what she has to create in her clay. She explains her method goes beyond touch. "Although it helps to have a physical model to feel and get inspiration from,

the important thing is really the mental image I get in my head," she says. "I visualize what I want the piece to look like." No matter how the pieces turn out in the end, Lavonne considers it to be a success. She is more concerned with how she feels in the moment of creation, thanks to the "meditative" quality of sculpting.

Jessica Curtaz, teaching artist for *Creating in Clay*, has a great appreciation for Lavonne's attention to detail. "I love watching Lavonne work," she says. "She takes so much time with the tactile models, that she usually starts working in clay ten minutes behind the rest of the class. She always seems to have a vision though, which she translates amazingly well. It's inspiring!"
