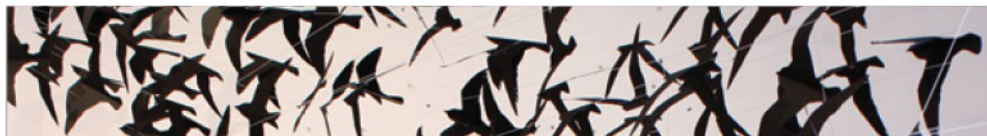

# ART STAR

## JUDI DISSIN

After raising her family and a successful career in advertising and production that took her from Philadelphia to New York, and back again, Judi Dissin decided that she was ready to make herself a priority. She had long dreamt of taking an art class, but it was a milestone birthday that sealed the deal. In fact, it was at her 75th birthday party that she announced to friends and family that she was gifting herself *me time*. She was going to take art classes at Main Line Art Center.

Drawn to collage, Judi registered for The 21st Century - Experiments In Mixed Media & Collage with Andrea Snyder in Winter Session 2016. Nervous at first, Judi became friendly with the people in her class, all different ages and skill levels, but found herself comparing her work to that of her new friends. When she mentioned this to Andrea, she was given advice that completely changed her perspective.

"I'll never forget what Andrea said to me," said Judi. "It was so poignant. She said, 'Never compare your work to anyone. This is what comes from you. Remember that.'"

With Andrea's words fresh in her mind, Judi couldn't believe how this changed her experience for the better. "I couldn't believe the things I was putting down," she said. "My brain opened up and I became totally uninhibited. Her words brought me out of my box and allowed me to pour out stuff I never knew I had. Now I get inspired by other people's work and their energy and excitement."

After her class was over, she registered for another...and plans to continue prioritizing her *me time* at Main Line Art Center. To other beginners, she offers these words of advice:

"It's never too late to explore art or nurture your imagination. Feel free to play with colors. Pick up a paintbrush. Take a class and you'll be energized and meet new people. There's no right or wrong. It's what you put down. That's art."
