JENNY DRUMGOOLE

Featuring 2017 Digital Artist in Residence Jenny Drumgoole
In association with *Panorama: Image-Based Art in the 21st Century*, next Biennial Festival coming in September 2018

Jenny Drumgoole is a Philadelphia video-based performance artist who inserts herself into marginal spaces of pseudo-celebrity within popular culture. Her most recent work involves physically and virtually infiltrating competitive events with subversive art actions, which are meant to question our obsessions with celebrity, desire, and the limits and illusions of individuality in popular culture.

The "Soxx For Mayor" series, shown most recently in Main Line Art Center's Happily Ever After exhibition, are meant to be both heartwarming and unsettling. Drumgoole's alter ego, Soxx, takes a very literal and child-like approach to navigating the world. Soxx's videos/performances explore human connections and contemporary systems, especially relating to work/laborers, and structures of power. Soxx dances across the line dividing self-involvement and the public sphere in an effort to penetrate and perhaps destroy the screens that keep us from connecting with each other in real time and space.

Drumgoole received her B.A. from Fordham University in New York and M.F.A. from Yale School of Art in Connecticut. Her performances have been exhibited at numerous spaces including The Keswick Theater in Glenside, PA, Vox Populi in Philadelphia, PA, BHQFU in New York, NY, Soho 20 in New York, NY, The Contemporary Arts Center in Cincinnati, OH, San Diego Women's Festival in California, Dallas Video Festival in Texas, Artcore Gallery in Toronto, Canada, The Center for Contemporary Art in Tel Aviv, Israel, and The New York Underground Film Festival. She was a 2015 United States Artist Fellowship Nominee and a discussion of her work, "The Cream Cheese Contest", can be found in the recently published *A Companion to Public Art*, Wiley-Blackwell Press (2016).
