## **Eligibility & Requirements**

All young artists (ages 5-16) who have taken a class or participated in Main Line Art Center Summer Camp, within the last three years, are invited to submit a piece for the exhibition. This is a great opportunity for your young artist to be part of a professional gallery show! It is highly recommended that 2-D work be framed and wired for the safety of the artwork. All mediums, styles, and abilities are welcome.

### **Electronic Submission**

Entries must be submitted electronically via http://mainlineart.slideroom.com by 11:59 pm on March 2 to be accepted into the exhibition. There is no application fee however, there is a \$5.00 processing fee paid to slideroom. We cannot accept paper applications. Work dropped off without prior registration to slideroom cannot be accepted, no exceptions.

# **Delivery & Pick up**

Hand deliveries of artwork only. Entries must be ready to display with completed entry form. All pieces must be labeled using the form provided below. Label should be securely fastened to the back of your piece. Due to lack of storage at the Art Center, pieces must be picked up by June 2 by 5pm.

### **Art Sales**

It is optional to sell artwork. If your young artist would like to keep their masterpiece, simply write "NFS" on the application when prompted for a price. The Art Center will retain 40% commission on all sales from its galleries.
