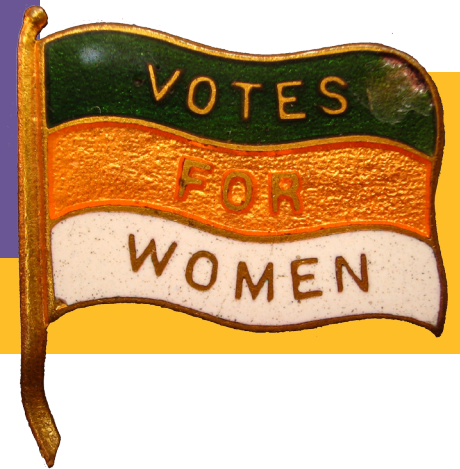


CALL FOR WOMEN ARTISTS!

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States, which granted women the right to vote. However, after the ratification, voting struggles continued for marginalized groups. This fall, Main Line Art Center will present a juried exhibition of 19 contemporary women and female identifying artists whose work responds to 100 years of women's suffrage and the women's rights movement then and now. This exhibition will not only be a commentary on historic events, but a deeper conversation of contemporary inequality by a variety of voices.

Artists should apply with artwork that explores and responds to the following questions:

What does 100 years of women's suffrage mean today - where are we now? How have marginalized groups been a catalyst for change throughout history? Artists should consider current events and their personal identity, in shaping their response.

Artists must be 18 years or older and be a resident of the United States in order to be eligible to apply. All female identifying artists are welcome to apply. Multidisciplinary, experimental, and installation works are encouraged. All mediums are welcome. There are no size limitations for work as long as work can conform with the gallery floorplan. Artists must submit 5 images of work for consideration. Multiple works by the same artist may be accepted into the exhibition. Artists must provide their CV, artist bio, and statement. Special consideration will be given to artists that are interested in leading a lecture, discussion, or participating on a panel related to the 19th Amendment and their work during the run of the exhibition. Please include appropriate proposal with your application in the "additional support materials" section. Artists are required to drop off and pick up work on designated days. Artwork provided with the application must be reserved and available for the exhibition. Artists will be notified of acceptance/rejection status in July 2020.
