Main Line Art Center offers its first residency for Artists with Disabilities. The center will host two residencies during our 2021-2022 fiscal year.

Dates:

Residency 1: September – February 2021

Application Due: August 1st, 2021

Residency 2: March – August 2022

Application Due: February 1, 2022

Residency Structure:

The Residency for Artists with Disabilities is for local emerging artists to have space to work, resources to create original artwork, and a public space to exhibit their artwork. Each resident will identify a common area of the Art Center and create a piece of public art as the culmination of their residency. Additional artwork created will be displayed in the Center's Welcome Gallery. Resident artists will work with a teaching artist mentor to target personal artistic goals and have the opportunity to be a guest artist in our classes.

- 6 month residency
- Creation of original public artwork at the Art Center
- Culminating exhibition
- \$2,000 resident stipend
- All supplies provided
- Teaching artist mentor
- Guest artist opportunities

Requirements to Apply:

- Artist must be 18 years or older and live in the greater Philadelphia area
- Artist must submit a completed application
