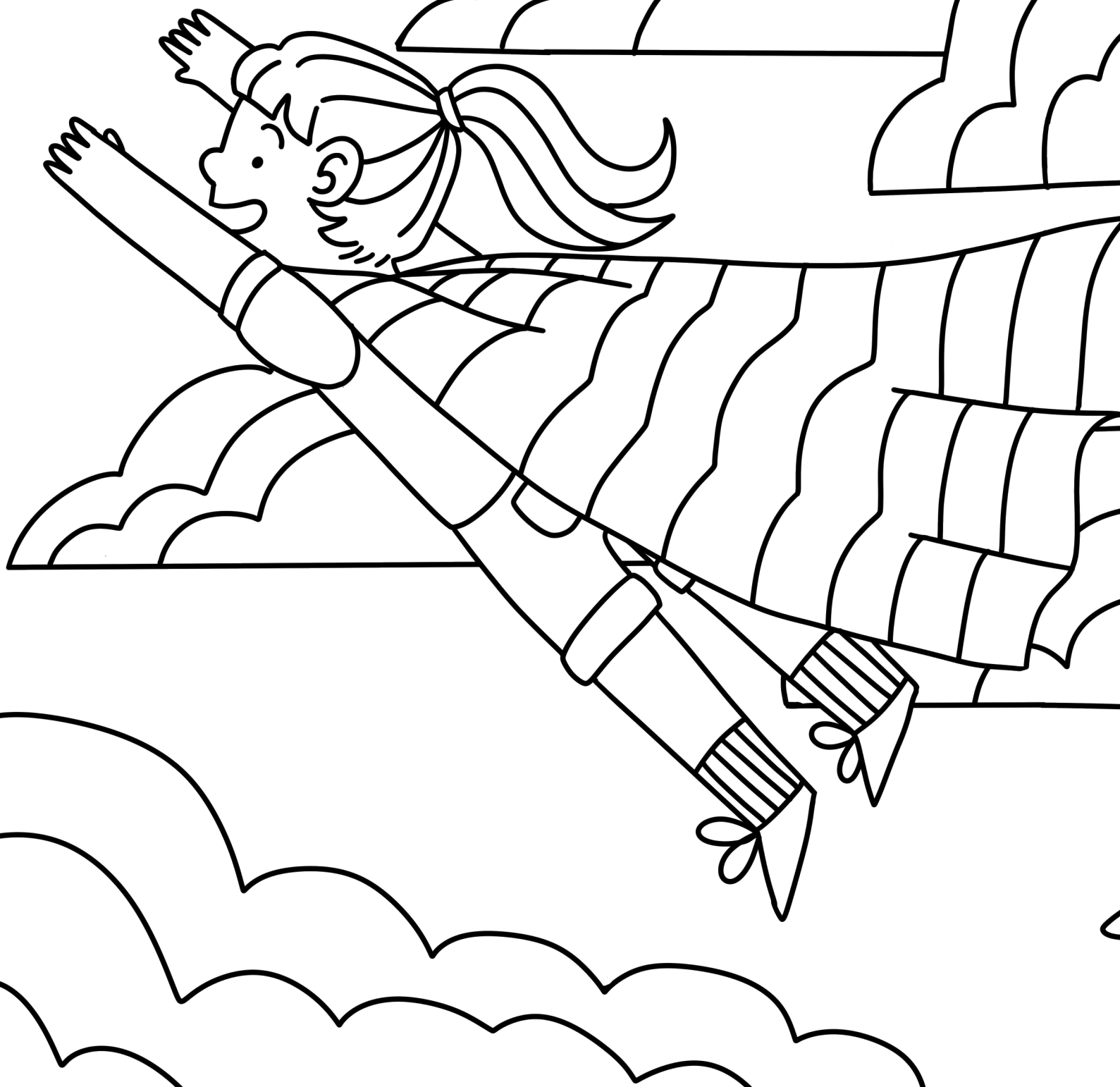



Celebrate the summer with splashes of color!



Camps have mandatory safety procedures informed by current CDC guidelines. Information about Covid policies will be shared with families before the start of their camp.

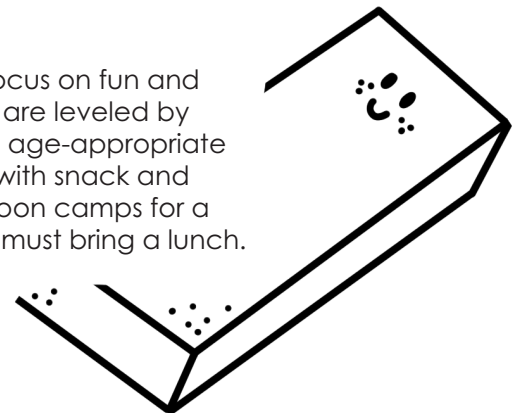


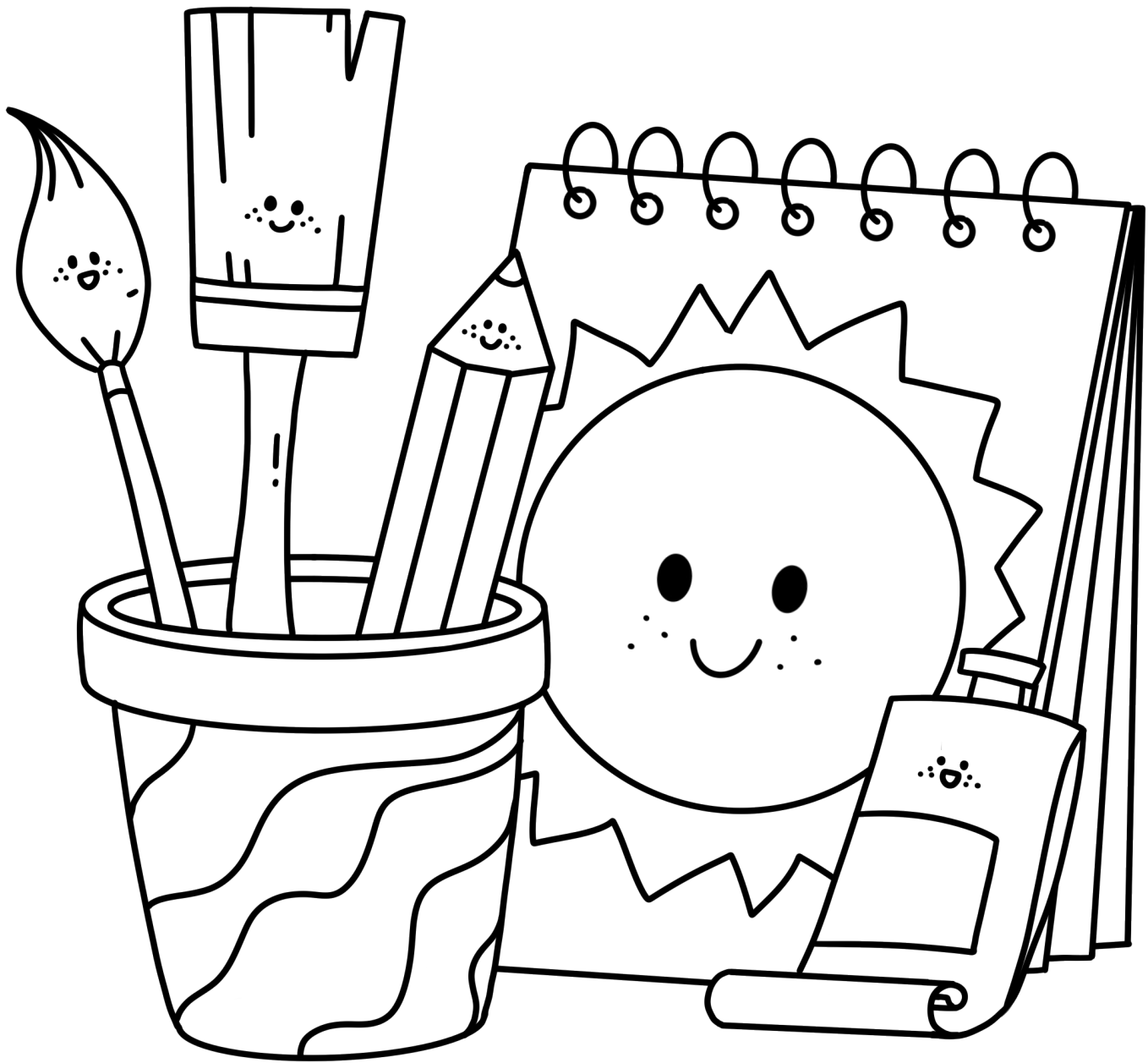

Scholarships & Accommodation


