Our Mission

The mission of Main Line Art Center is to inspire and engage people of all ages, abilities, and economic means in visual art through education, exhibitions, and experiences.

About Camp

All Teaching Artist Apprentices (TAAs) work during summer camp, which runs for 10 one-week sessions from June 20 to August 25, 2023. By participating in studios that cover a variety of mediums, campers ages 5-16 develop skills in collaboration, critical thinking, and self-expression. At the end of each week, campers display their artwork during our Friday Art Party.

Position Description

TAAs work with experienced, professional teaching artists to provide guidance to campers and learn about classroom management and curriculum development. This opportunity is for individuals who are passionate about art and art education and want to gain working knowledge of being a teaching artist. TAAs must be 15 years or older.

TAAs are required to work for a minimum of two weeks, either consecutive or non-consecutive. New TAAs receive a weekly stipend of \$100, and returning TAAs receive a weekly stipend of \$150. TAAs under age 18 must acquire a work permit from the school district in which they reside. All TAAs must provide a copy of Child Abuse & Criminal Background clearances.

Main Takeaways & Responsibilities

- Build confidence working with children of various ages in a range of mediums
- Gain classroom management experience, learn about curriculum planning, and practice effective communication for lesson delivery
- Supervise children during snack breaks, lunch, transitions between classes, and morning dropoff and afternoon pick-up. TAAs must feel comfortable instructing children and upholding basic rules and policies to maintain a safe, clean, and organized environment
- Assist with exhibition preparation and display for Friday Art Parties

Physical Requirements & Working Conditions

Must be able to remain in a standing or stationary position for extended periods of time. Must be able to adapt to high pace environments occasionally moving/lifting lightweight equipment and other work-related objects up to 25lbs. Must be able work outdoors for extended periods of time and interact with diverse groups of children, adults and families.
